Reviews

Three peer review committees were formed to review 12 packets (3 Assistant, 4 Associate, 5 Librarians). The review went smoothly (2 Assistant promoted to Associate, 1 Associate promoted to Librarian, the remaining are merit reviews) The CAP review process started in February 2010 when the Chair recruited chairs for the peer review committees. In March, the Chair submitted a list of names to AUL for Human Resources (HR) to be considered for service on the peer review committees. The review took place from April 12-May 3. One more packet scheduled for review in the previous year came in after the official review was completed. It was given to one of the peer review groups. In the end, two committees reviewed 4 packets and one committee reviewed 5 packets -- 13 packets in all.

CAP/WOM Brown Bag

The annual CAP/WOM review brown bag took place on December 9, 2009. The panelists this year, in addition to Cap Chair and WOM Chair, Janet Martorana, are Angela Boyd and Sherry DeDecker. The brownbag session provided the librarians up for review guidance and practical advice from the panelists as well as from other participating peers about the review process and helpful tips.
